1. OPENING REMARKS

Dr Lee Suan Yew gave a review of the year's work. Council had a busy year and amongst many things accomplished, he said two stood out as achievements, namely, the establishment of the new College premises in the COM Building and contribution to the University of Singapore's decision to include Family Medicine as an academic discipline in the undergraduate curriculum.

1.1 College's New Premises

The new premises have been designed to have two areas: one the administrative side which includes the Conference Room, the Visitors' lounge, the President's Room and the Secretariat; the other the functional area which includes the archives, the computer centre, the consultation room and a lecture theatrette. Several pieces of antiques and paintings by local artists have been purchased partly as an investment, partly to remind ourselves and to show our visitors our cultural heritage. Dr Lee paid tribute to the work which Dr Alfred Loh has done as Chairman of the College's New Premises Committee.

1.2 Division of Family Medicine in COFM

This is a milestone in the teaching of Family Medicine and a recognition of the efforts of the College of General Practitioners.

Dr Lee Suan Yew thanked the members of the Council and the Secretariat staff for the work they have put in as well as members for their support.

It was felt that since there is provision in the Constitution for a successor to be elected from Council, the matter should be left to the wisdom of the Council.

4. ANNUAL REPORT

The Annual Report was adopted. Dr Chee Phui Hung proposed and Dr Wong Heck Sing seconded.

5. AMENDMENTS TO CONSTITUTION

Dr Chee Phui Hung proposed that the amendments be adopted. Dr Wong Heck Sing seconded. The amendments were unanimously accepted.

6. AUDITED ACCOUNTS FOR YEAR 1986 - 87

Dr Chee Phui Hung proposed and Dr Leong Vie Chung seconded. It was adopted.

7. HONORARY FELLOW

The Censor-in-Chief told the House that Council had nominated Professor Edward P C Tock Honorary Fellow in recognition of his support for Family Medicine. This was unanimously accepted by the House.

8. ELECTION OF FELLOWS

Drs Goh Lee Gan and Alfred Loh were nominated Fellows of the College in recognition of their contribution to the College. This was unanimously accepted by the House.

11.1 Membership Drive

It was felt necessary that the College conducts a membership drive. The incoming Council will look into this.

11.2 Membership Fees

It was felt by some members that the membership fees may have to be raised to balance the expenditure that the larger College premises will incur. It was hoped that the membership drive may make it unnecessary to raise fees. The decision was deferred.

11.3 Continuing Medical Education

Some members expressed the need for a systematic approach to CME programmes. It was noted that several hospitals have begun CME programmes and it was felt that there is a need for some centralisation of action to maximise the organisers' efforts. Whilst the need for some co-ordination, if anything to reduce duplication, it was felt not easy to tell the hospitals what to do. Perhaps the College can concentrate on CME update courses and teaching seminars and leave the hospital to deal with more hands-on orientation to the various subjects useful to the General Practitioner.

12. VOTE OF THANKS

Dr Chee Phui Hung proposed a vote of thanks to the Council.

2. DIPLOMATE EXAMINATION 1988

The Diplomate Examination has been scheduled to be held in October/November 1988. Application to sit for the Examination was opened in January 1988 and closed on 30 April 1988. There was no examination in 1987.

The Board of Censors has recommended to Council that a Teaching Seminar on Family Medicine/General Practice be held for members who intend to sit for our Diplomate Examination, and others who are interested in learning more about the discipline of Family Medicine/General Practice. It was felt that the seminar would form the first step towards the establishment of vocational training in Family Medicine/General Practice.

3. TEACHING SEMINAR IN FAMILY MEDICINE

This seminar was opened by Professor Lee Hin Peng, Head of the Department of Community, Occupational and Family Medicine [COFM], National University of Singapore, on 9 January 1988.

The seminar consisted of 20 sessions, grouped into 4 modules. The sessions were held on Saturdays, from 2.30 - 5.30 pm at the Training Centre of our College.

1. TEACHING OF FAMILY MEDICINE/GENERAL PRACTICE TO MEDICAL STUDENTS

In the year under review the Committee did the following:

- 11 It held four meetings aimed at setting policies for research development, selection and design of research projects and their implementation.
- It completed a project on "A Study of Diabetes Mellitus in General Practice". Forty-five [45] General 21 Practitioners took part in this study covering the period 1 December 1987 to 28 February 1988. The study consisted of a protocol for recording the patient's diabetic history, medications, compliance with dietary advice, random blood glucose and HbA1 measurements. Data from 485 patients were obtained. The results should give useful information on the management of diabetes mellitus in general practice.
- It completed work concerning "A One-Day National Morbidity Survey of Outpatients in Singapore". 31 Tentatively, a day in July 1988 has been selected. The project has received the approval and support of the Singapore Medical Association, the Academy of Medicine, the Association of Private Medical Practitioners of Singapore and the Ministry of Health. The aim of the study is to see the morbidity pattern in both government and private generalists' and specialists' clinics on outpatients seen that day. Publicity will be given to highlight the reasons and usefulness of such a survey and to encourage all doctors concerned to take part.
- 4] It discussed the feasibility of three more projects namely:
 - a study of reason for encounter in the elderly patient at the GP Clinic. a]
 - a study on the effectiveness of low-dose Hepatitis B vaccination in GP-patients. bl
 - a study of in-house laboratory testing by GPs using the Reflotron autoanalyser. cl

The past financial year has seen an unprecedented increase in the annual expenditure of the College. This is to be expected with the move to the new college premises. There is [a] the increase in office staff, [b] the increased cost in maintenance of equipment and [c] the upsurge in college activities with the necessary increase in postage, stationery, printing, papers, etc. Recurrent expenditure items have been constantly reviewed by the Council to ensure no wastage or extragavance.

Whilst membership subscription continues to be the main source of income, a noticeable increase in revenue has occurred from fees collected from the various seminars and CME courses held by the College because of better support and attendances by members.

The Balance Sheet and Income/Expenditure statement, however, show that an increase in membership subscription would be necessary to maintain a healthy financial situation for the College in the years ahead. This would be better than having to increase fees for the various courses that the College would run in the future. Hence, the proposal by the Council for the adjustments to the membership subscription.

Other possible means of increasing College revenue that the Council has explored are [a] membership drive, [b] seeking advertisers for the College journal - The Singapore Family Physician, [c] seeking sponsorship, where appropriate, for some of the College events from pharmaceutical companies and [d] obtaining the best interest rates for fixed deposits of College funds.
